



JSMC Promoting Local Talent PhD Scholarship

For recent MSc graduates of the FSU Jena

The JSMC invites proposals for a fully funded PhD position with named candidates that have recently completed, or are about to complete, their MSc degree at the FSU Jena to a high standard. The financial support includes 3,5 years salary at 65% of TV-L 13 and an annual consumables budget of 10.000 euros. The project must cover research in microbiology but may also consist of other disciplines in the natural sciences, if it contributes significantly to novel method development for the microbial/life sciences.

Applications should consists of:

1. A Project Abstract (maximum 300 words)
2. Research Aims (maximum 100 words)
3. Research Strategy (maximum 1000 words)
4. Letters of support for the nominated candidate from the prospective first and second supervisors. This may be a single co-signed letter. The primary supervisor must be a JSMC faculty member.
5. A letter of motivation, CV and academic transcript of the candidate

Candidates must be able to start their work no later than the 1st of July 2021 and have graduated with a MSc degree by then. Proposals co-authored by the candidate and supervisors should be submitted by the primary supervisor as a single PDF file to hendrik.huthoff@uni-jena.de by **March 31st 2021**. All proposals will be evaluated by the JSMC executive board and a panel of external reviewers.
