

JSMC Travel Grant

Each JSMC doctoral candidate (officially admitted to the JSMC) is eligible to apply for travel support of a max. of **1.000 € once a year**. All JSMC postdoctoral researchers may apply for travel support of up to **2.000 € once a year**. Supported travels include all research or science trips, e.g. summer schools, conferences, meetings, workshops, etc., both nationally and internationally.

Please send your complete application as a **single PDF file** including a short cover letter (stating who you are, your affiliation and contact information of you and your PI, the scientific purpose of your travel, and how it fits your research project), confirmation of the conference contribution (e.g. poster or talk) or acceptance to a workshop, etc., a breakdown of all anticipated travel costs (e.g. tickets, registration fee, accommodation, etc.) and a short explanation why the financial support should be granted/your contributions to the *Excellence* at the JSMC (e.g. publications, seminar contributions, mentoring/tutoring of students, extracurricular activities, etc.). -> Please note that the success of your application strongly depends on individual participation at mandatory JSMC events, 'demonstrated excellence' (publications, presentations, extracurricular activities, etc.), and your overall respectful communication. Partial funding may be granted. Incomplete application will not be considered. Applications are accepted all year long.

-> Successful JSMC funding is to be mentioned in your presentation(s) and a summary shall be contributed to the JSMC (e.g. a summary for the JSMC newsletter or as a short presentation at Microverse JSMC Early Career Exchange Seminar).
